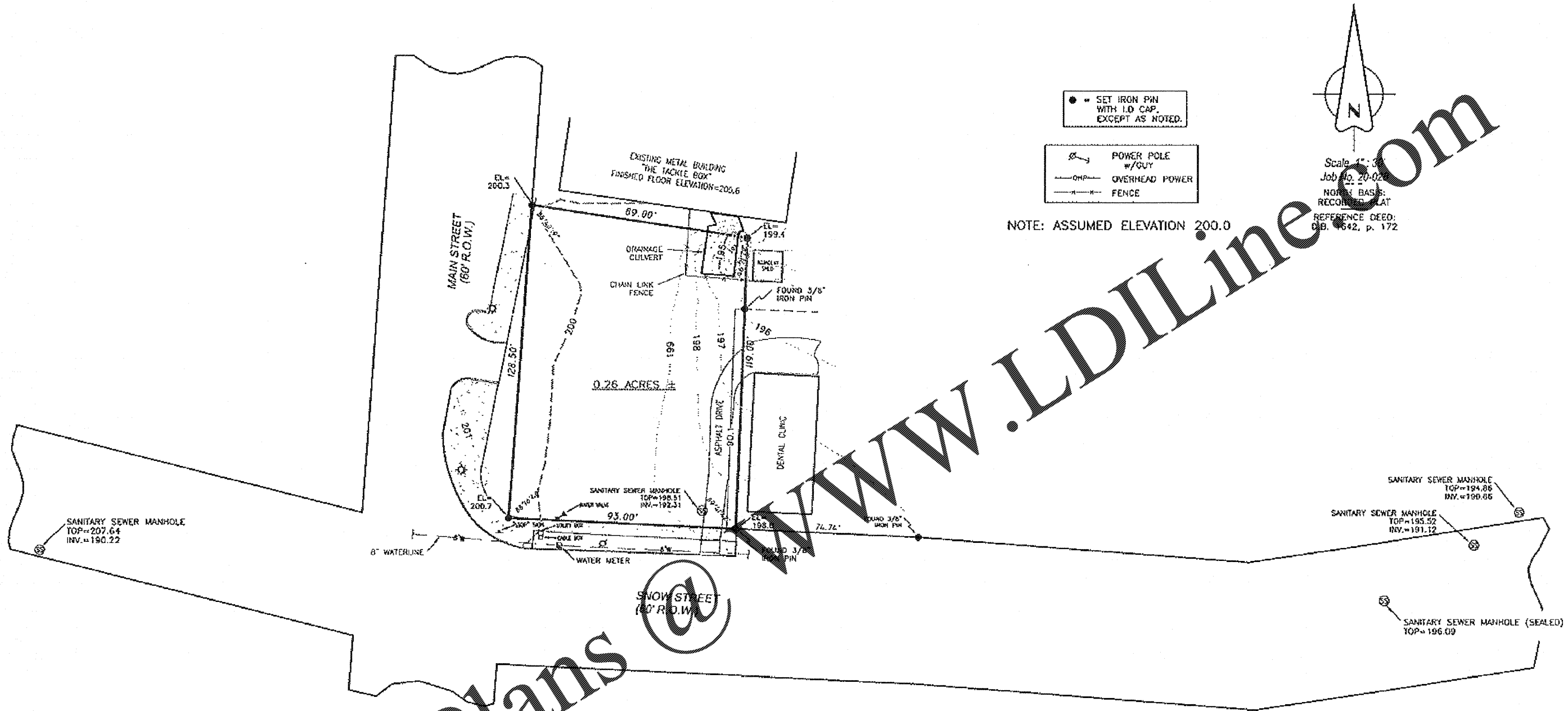


Part of Block 17, Map of Camp's Survey

I, BILLY D. GRIZZARD, A LICENSED LAND SURVEYOR IN THE STATE OF ALABAMA, HEREBY STATE THAT THE FOREGOING IS A MAP OF PART OF BLOCK 17, AS SHOWN ON THE MAP OF CAMP'S SURVEY OF OXFORD, ALABAMA, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST INTERSECTION OF MAIN STREET AND SNOW STREET; THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG THE EAST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF SAID MAIN STREET, A DISTANCE OF 128.50 FEET; THENCE EASTERLY AT AN INTERIOR ANGLE OF 85°40'19", A DISTANCE OF 89.00 FEET; THENCE SOUTHERLY AT AN INTERIOR ANGLE OF 98°21'20", A DISTANCE OF 119.00 FEET TO AN EXISTING 3/8" IRON PIN ON THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF SNOW STREET; THENCE WESTERLY AT AN INTERIOR ANGLE OF 89°41'42" ALONG SAID RIGHT OF WAY, A DISTANCE OF 93.00 FEET BACK TO THE BEGINNING POINT, CONTAINING 0.26 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.
